

## Little Fishy Dish


## realive Paradise Inc. Suggested Glass:

## **Materials:**

- GM2<u>17 Fish Texture Soap Dish</u>
- COE96 Glass (See Right)
- Suitable Glass Separator/ZYP
- Frit Placement Tools
- Glass Cutting Supplies

- F2 Fine:
  - Teal Green Trans.
  - Turns Pink Trans.
  - Pale Amber Trans.
  - Black
- **Sheet Glass:** 
  - Standard Thick Clear

Prepare the mold well with suitable glass separator before beginning. We recommend spray-on ZYP. If using spray-on separator, make sure to always wear a mask while applying.



After the separator has dried, begin by placing F2 Teal Green along the backs of each fish. A cut plastic pipette was used here for frit placement.



Add a stripe of F2 Turns Pink along the middle of each fish.



Fill the remaining empty parts of the fish with F2 Pale Amber.



Sprinkle some F2 Black here and there on the fish bodies.

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Cut and clean a 5.75" x 3.5" rectangle of Standard Thickness Clear sheet glass and center it on the mold. Move the project to a level shelf in the kiln and fire using the suggested schedule in **Table 1** or your own preferred Tack Fire.

4	9999	950**	90
